### A. Academics:

### Comprehensive Academic Excellence and Holistic Development at Our School

- 1. The school follows the CBSE curriculum.
- 2. Achieves 100% first-class results in 10th and 12th CBSE Board exams since 2013.
- 3. Special Doubt Solving Period (DSP) is provided for classes XI and XII.
- 4. Daily Practice Papers (DPP) are given for classes XI and XII.
- 5. Weekly tests for classes XI and XII are conducted as per NEET and JEE Mains patterns.
- 6. The school boasts highly qualified and experienced teaching faculty.
- 7. Comprehensive NEET and JEE Mains preparation is provided.
- 8. A Booster Plan for Class XII ensures thorough exam readiness with regular practice.

- 9. Motivational speeches are organized regularly to inspire students.
- 10. Each classroom is equipped with digital smart boards.
- 11. Career counselling, aptitude tests, and expert guidance are offered for classes X and XII.
- 12.Regular classroom supervision is conducted by the Director, Principal, and Vice-Principal.
- 13.**Revision Plan** A structured day-wise revision plan is implemented for classes X to XII after syllabus completion.
  - Regular class tests, group tests, and mock tests are conducted for all subjects.
  - Test results are shared with parents via WhatsApp for progress tracking.
  - Classes are shuffled into performance-based groups like Homi Bhabha, Aristotle, Newton, and Raman for focused preparation.
- 14.IIT and NEET foundation courses for grades VI to X are conducted by expert faculty to build a strong academic base for competitive exams.
- 15. Activity-Based Learning (ABL) and Project-Based Learning (PBL) methodologies enhance the teaching-learning process for classes I to X.
- 16.Remedial coaching classes are provided for slow learners.
- 17.Student-cantered daily assemblies include prayers, thoughts of the day, passage readings, science activities, quizzes, news, and value-based messages.
- 18. Weekly language lab periods improve LSRW (Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing) skills in English.
- 19. Three computer labs cater to primary, secondary, and higher secondary students, ensuring individual hands-on experience.
- 20.Small class sizes allow teachers to focus on individual attention.
- 21. Digital Interactive Boards with teaching aids are used in all classrooms for effective learning.
- 22. Trained teachers use PPTs and QR Code-enabled study notes for teaching.
- 23. Hard copies of homework, notes, question banks, and study materials are provided to students.
- 24. Students follow a structured schedule for homework, classwork, and workbook corrections
- 25. Results of unit tests and term exams are displayed for student motivation.
- 26.Photos of "Gems" (class rankers) and "Stars" (school rankers) are displayed after each examination.
- 27. Feedback Certificate: After each examination, students receive a feedback certificate detailing their skill-wise performance in every subject.
- 28.Behavioural Chart 'Learning Ladder': The school provides a term-wise behavioural chart, highlighting students' personal, social, emotional, and physical development.
- 29. Aptitude and career counselling sessions are scheduled for student guidance.

30. Eligible students in classes IX and XI are admitted under the 'SHRESHTA Scheme' for residential education in targeted areas.

- **2. Well-Equipped Library:** Our school library houses over 5000 books, including reference materials, newspapers, periodicals, and magazines, providing a wide range of reading options for students.
- **3.** The school has well-equipped labs for: ScienceLabs: Physics, Chemistry, Biology,Mathematics andLanguage Lab: The language lab is equipped with 36 computers and language software, which helps students improve their language skills and pronunciation.
- **4.Computer Labs:** There are two computer labs one for primary students and another for secondary students. Each lab has 36 computers, ensuring that every student gets hands-on experience with computers.
- **5. Wellness Room**: The school has a wellness room with six beds and a nurse available to take care of sick or injured students and staff.
- **6. School Website:** Our website, www.stnms.in, is regularly updated to keep stakeholders informed. We also upload videos of school events on Facebook to keep everyone connected.
- **8. CCTV Surveillance:** The entire campus, including 50 classrooms and corridors, is under CCTV surveillance for safety and security. Each school bus is also equipped with CCTV cameras, ensuring a secure environment.
- **9. School Bus Facility:** The school operates 20 buses, with two additional buses purchased this year. Each bus is equipped with a GPS tracking system, allowing parents to track their child's bus in real-time.
- **10. PTA** (**Parents & Teacher Association**): We have a PTA association to gather valuable feedback from parents and sustain educational progress.

- **11. Teachers' Training:** To stay updated, our teachers attend various training programs organized within the school or at other branches of our institution.
- **12. Hostel Facility:** Two new hostel buildings separately for boys and girls have been added to our infrastructure this year with well-equipped rooms for providing nearly 280 students a supporting living environment. Both hostels are supervised by wardens and a rector.
- **13. 1-BHK Flats for Teachers:** The school has newly constructed 1BHK flats as additional facilities for the teaching faculty.
- **14. Green Campus:** The green project for beautification has been completed, creating a pleasant and eco-friendly learning environment for students.
- **15. Security Guards:** Entire school building is being watched 24/7 in rotation duties along with special attention for each and every building separate provision of security guard is available.
- **16.** Children's Park: We have a center of attraction in our school premises. It has variety of features including a merry-go-round and seesaw, making it a popular spot for students.
